Be a tomato expert!

tomatoes this month? You
can help them out with
some expert advice!
1)Have everyone in your
house save egg shells
for a few weeks.

When you are ready to plant tomatoes, crush the eggshells into a powder, and sprinkle the powder into the planting hole before you put the tomato in. This provides calcium!
